
Background


- The need for renewal
 - TUTKA's core dates to 2002
 - The complexity of publication reporting needs increases
 - Various universities have procured (or in process) a commercial research information system
 - The reliability of the project/financial information and data in other sections in TUTKA?
 - The scope of the CRIS in the future system architecture?
 - Open Access, performance assessment, student theses, data warehouse, societal interaction, CV, research datasets...
- TUTKA working group (2013)
 - Primary requirements for the research information system
 - Scope: publications, projects with additional funding, international mobility, essential scientific rewards
 - Evaluation of implementation options
 - Initial requirements specification to support the tendering process



CRIS renewal project 2014-2015

- Steering group for research information systems (incl. research datasets, JYX)
 - The focus in Spring 2014: preparation for the tendering process
 - Explicating the requirements, clarifying processes
 - Usability testing as part of the process
- TUTKA will be used in its current form at least in 2014
 - Recording publications is centralized to the Library
 - Transition to the new system can be carried out in stages
- The most fundamental changes are related to handling projects with additional funding
 - Project announcements, re-evaluating Dynasty
 - Utilizing financial data from SAP via data warehouse





Centralized recording of publications

- Starting in April 2014 JyU Library will record all publications to TUTKA
 - Publications will no longer be reviewed at the departments
 - The role of people in charge of publications will end (=transferred to the Library)
- The tasks of the department's main user remain unchanged
 - Acting as a contact person and "support" (related to all other information in TUTKA), managing user lists, etc.
- Researchers must still record other information to TUTKA (depending on department's conventions) by themselves
 - ...and ensure that the Library is notified about the publications comprehensively

Preliminary recording process

- Notifications: <u>tutka-publications@jyu.fi</u>
 - The message should include basic information about the publication, and the pdf file, unless already online (book chapters should include front matter/title page as well)
 - The notification should also include information about authors' departments, and collaborative organizations (unless present in the publication)
 - Parallel publishing to JYX digital archive can be carried out with the address (=the Library will check the publisher permits). All articles should still be parallel published whenever possible.
- The Library will contact the researcher or departmental main user concerning unclear data (=e.g. peer review)
 - The researcher will be notified when the record is ready and accepted (or rejected, if the publication cannot be included in TUTKA) to check that the data is correct

Change requests to publication data will be addressed to the Library

Potential prospects for TUTKA development

- Allow recording certain publications that fall outside the national reporting criteria
 - E.g. translations, certain edited books
- Development supporting centralized recording
 - Importing reference data, UI improvements
- Extending search and reporting functionalities
 - Utilizing the Publication forum classes in reports
 - Interface to Data warehouse (publications+travels)
- After the introduction of IDM: logging in to TUTKA using JYU credentials
- Preparation for the new system
 - Clarifying external organizations and project data
 - Cleaning up duplicate entries

Conclusion

- The research information system will be renewed during 2014-2015
 - Explicating the system requirements and clarifying processes is now under way
 - The most likely implementation option is procuring a commercial research information system (the final decision is made based on tendering)
- TUTKA is still developed during the transition phase
- JyU Library will record the publication data in a centralized way
 - New notification address in addition to tutka-support: tutka-publications@jyu.fi
 - The library will announce the details about the notification process
 - The recording process is under ongoing development
 Centralized recording will be applied with the future
 CRIS as well.
